



Dear Parents, carers and students,

I am writing with regards to the planned Year 10 internal exams.

The end of Year 10 exams will take place from Tuesday 5th May onwards.

The internal exams for RE English Language, English Literature, and Maths will take place in the exam hall under strict exam conditions. Science exams will take place during lessons.

Please see attached timetable.

This will mirror the experience the students will have in their Year 11 Mock exams next academic year in order to prepare for their external exams.

The exams taking place in the exam hall will start at 9am and afternoon exams will start at 1.30. We will arrange an early lunch so students are ready for the 1.30pm exam. Students must ensure they arrive on time for all exams or they may be refused entry.

All other subjects will take place in lesson time. A timetable for these is attached.

A list of revision topics have been attached, but we recommend their revision of year 10 is continuous in order to support their progress in Year 11.

The Year 10 mocks will form part of the evidence of the tier entry of a subject, Higher or Foundation and their predictions. We can only base tier on evidence we have seen through mocks therefore, I would encourage students to ensure that they are revising thoroughly. It is important that students are aware of this.

Students will have a detailed assembly with the full plan and if they have any questions, they are welcome to come and see me.
