Dear Parents and Carers,

Re- Enrichment Day

As part of this academic year's KS3 Enrichment Day, Year 9 students will have the exciting opportunity to attend Stubbers Adventure Centre in Upminster on **Wednesday 11th March 2026**.

This full day program of fun and challenging outdoor activities is designed to develop teamwork, build resilience and support student's personal growth.

Students will travel by coach, departing school at 8:00am and returning at approximately 6:00pm. The day will include four 90-minute activities and a one-hour lunch break. Please ensure your daughter brings a packed lunch with ample snacks and drinks.

Thanks to the generous support from the school PTFA and the Jack Petchey Foundation, we have been able to reduce the overall cost of the trip. The final cost is **£55 per student**, which includes return coach travel, all activities, and all required equipment.

- **£20 deposit** via Parent pay by **5th December 2025**
- **£20 instalment** via Parent pay by **30th January 2026**
- **£15 instalment** via Parent pay by **28th February 2026**

Although attendance is not compulsory, we are keen on all students to share this enriching experience.

To support families, payment can be made in instalments. You are of course welcome to pay the full amount earlier if you prefer.

Please make the initial deposit on Parent Pay as soon as possible, and no later than **Friday 5th December**, to secure your daughter's place. We sincerely hope that every student in the year group will be able to take part.

Please note that some activities may take place on water. You will be required to give permission for this via Evolve nearer the date of trip.

This promises to be a fantastic opportunity for students to challenge themselves, collaborate with their peers and create lasting memories.
