Full stop (.)

To show the end of a sentence.

Comma (,)

To list or to separate clauses.

Exclamation mark (!)

To end a sentence and show shock or surprise.

Question mark (?)

To pose/end a question.

Apostrophe (')

To show possession or omission.

Speech marks ("")

To show direct speech – the exact words spoken or quoted.

Colon (:)

To introduce a list, statement or quote in a sentence.

Semi colon (;)

To separate two sentences that are related and of equal importance.

Hyphen (-)

To separate extra information from the main clause by holding words apart

Dash (–)

To add extra information in the middle

TOP TIPS

A step-by-step guide on how to find a Bible reference

Step 1: Find out from the contents if the book is Old or New Testament

Step 2: Turn to the page number for the book
(Remember some Bibles start at pg. 1 again in the New Testament)

Step 3: To find the chapter look for the big number

Step 4: Within the chapter find the verse using the little number

Step 5: Read it!!

Book

At top or in corner of page, find this **1st**

Chapter

Larger number in the text, at the start of paragraphs, find **2nd**

Verse

Small number throughout the text, find **last**

The Genealogy of Jesus Christ

1 The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. ¹Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers, ²and Judah the father of Perez and Zerah by Tamar, and Perez the father of Hezron, and Hezron the father of Ram. ³And Ram the father of Amminadab, and Amminadab the father of Nahshon, and Nahshon the father of Salmon, ⁴and Salmon the father of Boaz by Rahab, and Boaz the father of Obed by Ruth, and Obed the father of Jesse, ⁵and Jesse the father of David the king. And David was the father of Solomon by the wife of Uriah, ⁶and Solomon the father of Roboam, and Roboam the father of Abiam, and Abiam the father of Asaph, ⁷and Asaph the father of Jehoshaphat, and Jehoshaphat the father of Joram, and Joram the father of Uzziah, ⁸and Uzziah the father of Jotham, and Jotham the father of Ahaz, and Ahaz the father of Hezekiah, ⁹and Hezekiah the father of Manasseh, and Manasseh the father of Amon, ¹⁰and Amon the father of Josiah, ¹¹and Josiah the father of Jechoniah and his brothers, at the time of the deportation to Babylon.

¹²And after the deportation to Babylon: Jechoniah was the father of Shealtiel, and Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel, ¹³and Zerubbabel the father of Abiud, and Abiud the father of Eliakim, and Eliakim the father of Azor, ¹⁴and Azor the father of Zadok, and Zadok the father of Achim, and Achim the father of Eliud, ¹⁵and Eliud the father of Eleazar, and Eleazar the father of Manasse, and Manasse the father of Joseph, ¹⁶and Joseph the father of Jesus, who is called Christ.

betrothed² to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. ¹⁸And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. ¹⁹But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²⁰She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." ²¹All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:
