Information for Applicants

Application to our mixed Sixth Form is open to all internal and external Year 11 students.

1. It is expected that you are aware of the requirements to enter the Sixth Form. This information is found within the Sixth Form Prospectus: Course Guide September 2020.
2. You should choose carefully the subjects you wish to study and ensure that you have read the course information booklet. You should also check that these courses will be suitable for your choice of future career.
3. The subject blocks will be constructed to enable the greatest number of students to study the subjects of their choice. At this stage we are still considering the best way in which to block these subjects and some combinations may not be possible.
4. Please note that a subject may not run if there is insufficient demand for it.
5. The closing date for applications is the final day of the autumn term 2019, **20th December 2019**. Applications after this date may be considered if places are available, but the process may be delayed and choices restricted.
6. The completed application should be returned to Ms C Smyth, Admissions Officer. Internal students may give their application directly to Ms C Smyth.
7. For external applicants, on receipt of your application, confirmation of your target/estimated grades will be requested from your present school.
8. Offers will be made to students whose confirmed target/estimated grades meet the entrance requirements. Please note that the offer is subject to the required grades being achieved in the GCSE examinations.
9. Where target/estimated grades do not suggest suitability for our Sixth Form, applicants will be notified as soon as possible.
10. All applicants who receive an offer of a Sixth Form place will be expected to attend the Sixth Form Induction Day. Further details will be advised in due course.
11. External applicants are asked to provide the school with a copy of their GCSE results sheet/s as soon as they are available and no later than Midday on Thursday 20 August 2020.
