Transport Overview

St Bernard's High School is situated close to the A13 and so benefits from many bus routes running to and from the town centre. It is also very close to the C2C railway line, with Westcliff station just a short walk away. Southend Victoria, on the Abellio Greater Anglia is also accessible with a 10 to 15 minutes walk. Consequently, St Bernard's students are regular users of these public transport facilities.

Stephensons' buses also provide routes across the Borough that specifically cater for the student population, the routes and times can be found on the following website www.stephensonsofessex.com and allows you to look at the cost and to buy your ticket. The company is also able to provide a text service that allows parents and students to receive alerts when traffic issues arise affecting the timing of the buses.

The direct debit scheme is most cost-effective solution for both students under the age of 16 and for Sixth Form students.
